Office Waste Reduction

Printing: We minimize the need for printing by promoting digital documentation and communication. Printing is only done when absolutely necessary.

Recycling: We have a robust recycling program in place. All waste is segregated into plastic, paper, glass and other recyclables to ensure that as much waste as possible is diverted from landfills.

Reuse of Packaging: Where possible, we reuse packaging materials that are still in good condition, reducing the need for new materials and minimizing waste.

Ink Cartridges: All used ink cartridges are recycled through certified recycling programs.

Electronic Waste: Old computers and other electronic equipment are donated or repurposed, extending their lifecycle and reducing electronic waste.

Recycling Information: To promote recycling and responsible disposal, our product labels include clear recycling information in compliance with the European Parliament and Council Directive 97/129/EC on packaging and packaging waste.

Sustainable Packaging: We are committed to exploring and utilizing environmentally friendly packaging options whenever new packaging is required.

Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR): The EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR), entering into force on February 11, 2025, and applying from August 12, 2026, aims to make all packaging in the EU market recyclable by 2030 and significantly reduce waste. Sisterna will be working on her packaging to meet the upcoming requirements regarding recycled content, recyclability, potential reusability and related aspects.
