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All sucrose esters with less than 7% of tetra and higher esters are registered under E473. This regulation is applicable for Sisterna SP30, Sisterna SP50, Sisterna SP70 and Sisterna PS750.

The use of sucrose esters is regulated in EC Directive 1129/2011 of 11-11-2011. Amending Annex II to Regulation (EC) No. 1333/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council by establishing a Union list of food additives. Sucrose esters are allowed in a range of product categories with maximum dosages, see table I
