2025 Achievements

Digital Christmas Cards: By sending our Christmas cards digitally instead of through traditional postal methods, we eliminated the need for paper and reduced the carbon footprint associated with transport.

Environmentally Friendly Packaging: Whenever we needed new packaging, we prioritized the selection of environmentally friendly options, contributing to our sustainability goals.

Disposal of plastic: Verpact promotes circular economy by organising the collection and recycling of plastic packaging and deposit bottles in the Netherlands. Sisterna has registered for her location for the free collection of plastic packaging, drink cartons (PD) and/or glass packaging from commercial waste. The goal is 100% recyclable packaging by 2030, with a focus on reduce, reuse, and recycle.

Future goals

100% Sustainable Packaging by 2028: We aim to ensure that all packaging used in our operations is sustainable by 2028. This involves a thorough review of current packaging materials and the adoption of alternatives that are eco-friendly.

Improved Sample Packaging: We plan to enhance the sustainability of our personal care sample packaging. This will involve reducing the environmental impact of these materials while maintaining the quality and integrity of our products.

Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR): The EU Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR), entering into force on February 11, 2025, and applying from August 12, 2026, aims to make all packaging in the EU market recyclable by 2030 and significantly reduce waste.

Sisterna will be working on her packaging to meet the upcoming requirements regarding recycled content, recyclability, potential reusability and related aspects.

Disposal of plastic: The goal is 100% recyclable packaging by 2030, with a focus on reduce, reuse, and recycle.
